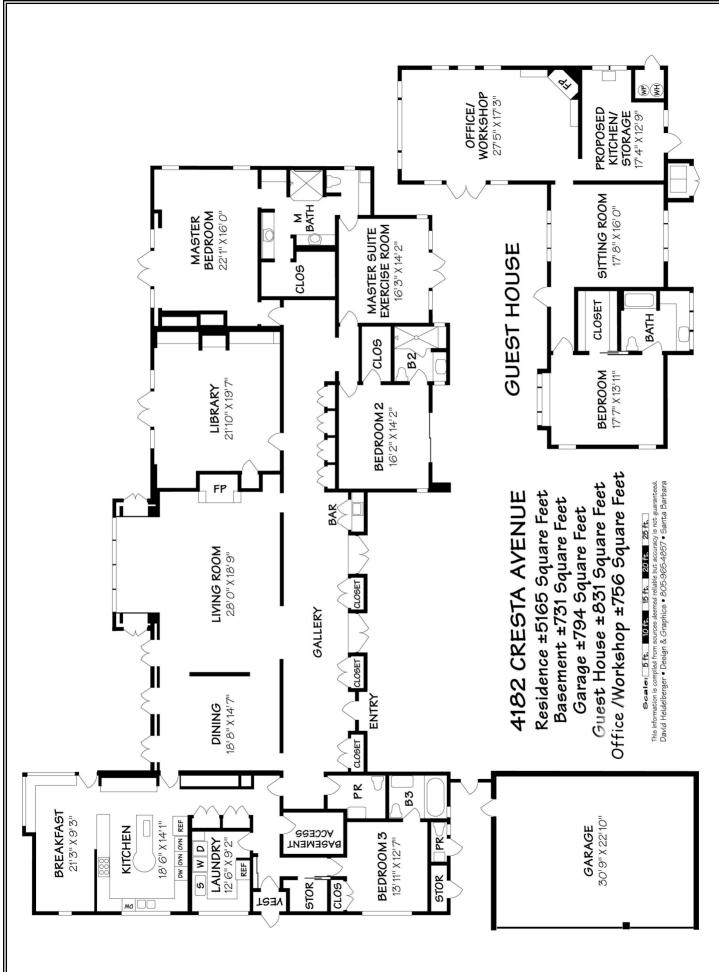
The home spans over 7,000 sq. feet of comfortable living and entertaining space on just under four acres. This private, gated estate offers formal living and dining rooms, library/game room, gourmet kitchen, master suite with adjoining exercise room and two additional bedrooms with en-suite baths in the main residence. There is a spacious separate guesthouse with private entrance.

Everything within the walls was creatively designed and implemented in the remodeling process of the home. Amazing detail permeates the entire residence featuring ebonized pegged oak flooring, custom windows and doors, walnut shoji screens, polished mesquite stone walls, state of the art sound system and entertainment bar. The kitchen features new anigre heavy figured custom cabinets with birch and stainless steel accents and black galaxy granite counters to promote interest and a sense of timelessness.

The extraordinary landscape plan for the property includes a total renovation of over 2 acres of the property. A 7,000 gallon koi pond, oversized spa and a 40-foot infinity fountain setting off the view of the mountains and the city to the north. A professional mixture of drought resistant materials, roses, agave and succulent gardens. An organic garden is off the kitchen for fresh herbs and vegetables. Trees include oak, avocado, lemon, lime, macadamia nut, persimmon, tangerine and orange along with other varieties. There is an extensive use of natural stone on the hardscape. Patios are Colorado quartzite, bluestone pavers and large granite boulders imported and strategically placed around the site.

Two notable features of the courtyard garden, including the koi pond, are the New England granite slab wall (aka Stonehenge) which provides separation from the south lawn area to the front courtyard and a dry rock stream bed which seasonally brings forward an exciting watercolor of plants including, blood grass, star jasmine, agapanthus, orchids, rock roses, a variety of blubs, grasses, plants and ground cover.
