Originally featured in a 1926 issue of *Architectural Digest*, this Montecito house was designed by Wallace Neff, one of California's most celebrated architects. The four-bedroom, four-bathroom home is considered one of the best representations of Spanish Colonial Revival architecture in California. Classic Spanish architectural elements such as white stucco walls, red tile roofs, archways and wrought iron are integrated throughout Neff's clean, simple

design. Custom details such as one-of-a-kind Spanish tiles and original carved wood doors

and shutters have been authentically restored.

The first floor features a great room with a cathedral wood beamed ceiling and mezzanine area, dining room, and sunroom. Completely updated, the kitchen features state-of-the-art appliances. A loggia leads to the second floor and overlooks the great room. Two bedrooms with terraces are on the second floor; two additional bedroom suites are located on the first floor. The grounds include a gated semi-circular entry court, rear fountain, and a 600 square-foot basement/wine cellar.

Great Room 32' x 16' – Original terracotta tile inset with hand-painted ceramic tile

and a carved wood door with an iron grille grace the entry foyer which opens to the massive great room. Crowned by a wood-beamed ceiling with a Mission-style chandelier, this impressive room contains a large

fireplace and a mezzanine – perfect for sculpture or a piano.

<u>Dining Room</u> 14' x 15' – Accessed from the family room and kitchen, the dining room

has wood floors and views to the outside landscape.

Family Room 16' x 20' – This large, light-filled room features a Saltillo tile floor with

Spanish tile insets and recessed lighting. Sliding glass doors open to the

patio and view the outdoor fountain and green, lush landscape.

Kitchen 10' x 13' – The kitchen is a seamless blend of classic and modern

amenities: a 1940s Wolf range is against a natural stone back splash; original terracotta tile provides a contrast to white wood cabinetry. A

center island with sink offers an additional preparation area.

Office 11' x 9' – Formerly a part of the maid's quarters, this suite is located off

the kitchen's breakfast area, and can serve as a home office/studio or

bedroom. Full bathroom.

Bedroom 11' x 10' – Also a part of the maid's quarters, this charming extra room

has beamed ceilings and Saltillo tile floors.

Second Floor

Master Bedroom 16' x 13' - A corner fireplace and wood floors lend to the cozy

ambiance of the master bedroom. The spacious master bathroom

features a large, open shower of tumbled marble, and a granite his and

her vanity.

Bedroom 15' x 14' – Wood floors, full bathroom, French doors open to deck.

Bedroom 17 x 13' – Wood floors, full bathroom, French doors open to deck.
